Lois Ehlert was an American illustrator and author of multiple children's books. She is known for her collages, bright colors, and various shapes and materials in her illustrations. We'll talk

about how she became interested in art as a child and take a look at some of her work.

Then we'll create our own Ehlert-inspired art!

Materials needed:

Crayons

Glue (white glue like Elmer's)

Construction paper - at least two large pieces

Scissors (to be used by child or adult)

Sheets of leaves (see below)

Photocopy the sheets of leaves on the following pages.

Participants will be coloring and cutting them during our art project. (You can also color and cut some before our program if you want.)

Options:

- 1. You are welcome to cut out your own leaves during the program.
- 2. If you have time, you can also collect some pretty dry leaves from the ground, put them in between pages of a heavy book, leave them there for a week or so, and have them ready for our program on the 20th of November.

NOTE: Paper is easier to work with than the real leaves.
